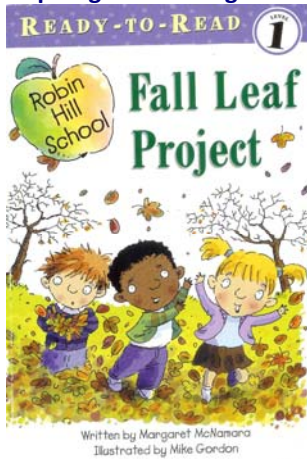




# ACES STUDENTS PARTNER WITH CHICAGO SCHOOL FOR FALL PROJECT
